# iPADS

- using the iPad as a learning tool
- keeping your iPad clean
- using headphones only when requested by the teacher
- keeping iPad off and away, unless given permission
- holding your iPad with two hands

# DISMISSAL AND BUS

We are *safe, respectful, and responsible*

by...

- using PAX Hands and Feet
- walking with teacher and class in line
- walking and waiting on sidewalk
- sitting “seat to seat, back to back” on the bus
- talking in a 3 foot voice on the bus (normal voice)
- cleaning up your area on the bus and saving food & drinks for home

# RESTROOM

We are *safe, respectful, and responsible*

by...

- washing our hands with soap and water
- waiting outside the restroom if all of the stalls are full; then *go, flush, wash, back to class*
- keeping the space clean (paper towels in garbage, flushing the toilet)

- talking in 3 foot voices (normal talk)
- using PAX hands and feet
