Grammar: Adjectives

The words *the*, *a*, and *an* are adjectives called **articles**. *The* is a **definite article** because it points out a specific person, place, or thing. *A* and *an* are **indefinite articles** because they refer to any person, place, or thing. Use *an* before a noun that begins with a yowel sound.
