Elisa's DiaryGrammar: Singular and
Plural Nouns

A **singular noun** names one person, place, thing, or idea.

A **plural noun** names more than one person, place, thing, or idea. Form the plural of most nouns by adding *-s* or *-es*. Look at the ending of a singular noun to decide how to form the plural.
